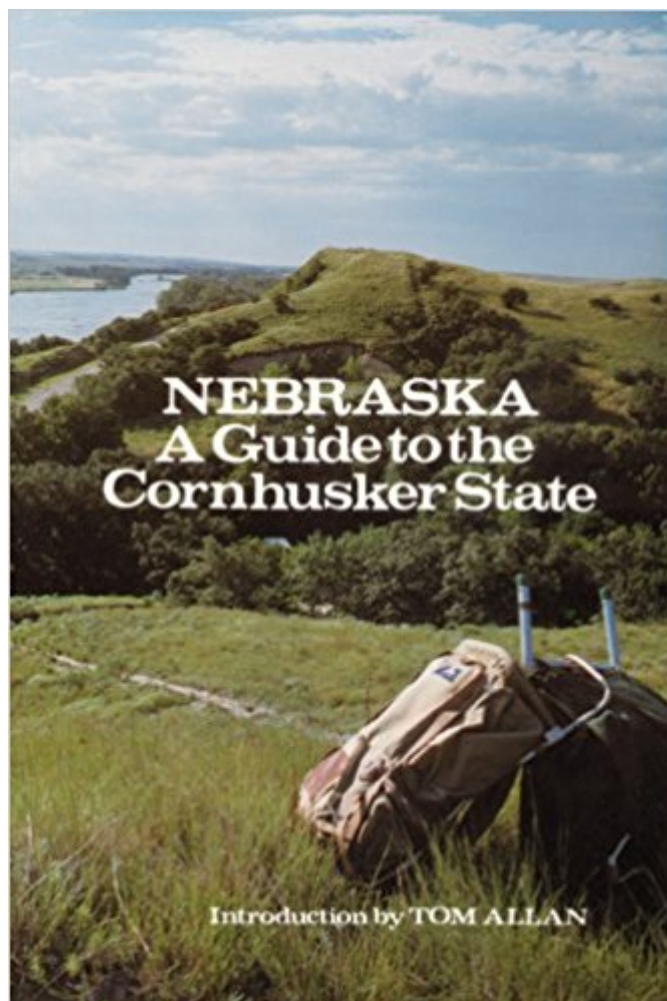

Tom Allan, veteran roving reporter for the Omaha World Herald, has written a new introduction which bridged the years between 1939 and 1979 and reveals some of his own off-the-beaten-path discoveries. Rewarding reading for the armchair traveler and an indispensable companion for the tourist, *Nebraska: A Guide to the Cornhusker State* will delight and inform all those interested in Nebraska and the Great Plains region.
