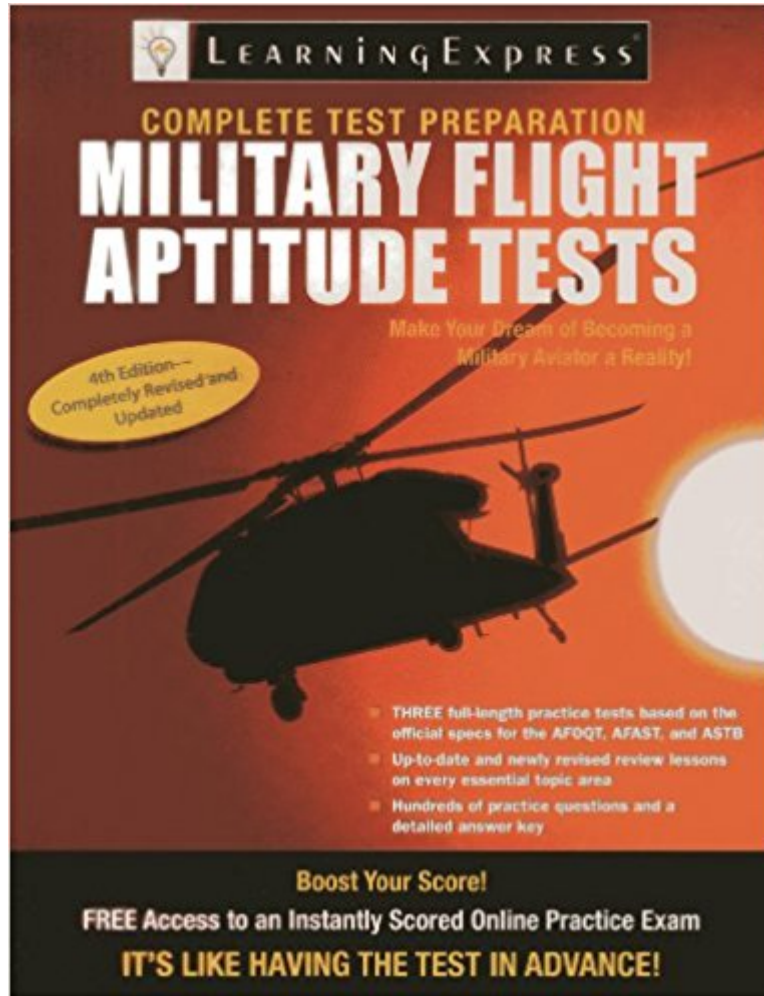

-Updated-I have reduced my original review by one star, the new book will offer a "free" online version of the test. I took the sample AFOQT provided in the book and wanted to then take the online version (hoping it was different). The online version is identical to the test in the book, the only advantage is that it is timed to help you pace yourself. If I knew it was the same test I would

have just did the online version. To date I recommend Barron's Military Flight Aptitude Test. I picked up this book because I was looking to study for the AFOQT and it is a newer publication. I would not use this as an instrument of instructions in areas you need work, but instead as a workbook for the test you are taking. The chapters are laid out below so you can judge for yourself if it is for you. Expect to get a few hours use out of it, as you most likely will take the sample test, see where they explain the answer, then take the test applicable to your branch and a nice feature is the book includes a code for an online version of the test that is timed so you can further practice the experience. Chapter 1 Becoming a Military Aviator (I skipped because I am not trying to become a pilot (Non-rated) Chapter 2 Aviation Opportunities in Each Branch of the Military (Skipped once again) Chapter 3 Test Maneuvers: Explanation of Military Flight Aptitude Tests (describes each branch test) Chapter 4 Sample Military Flight Aptitude Test Questions (Includes all sections for all three tests (about 5 questions each), so some you may skip) Chapter 5 Sample Military Flight Aptitude Test Answers (So you can check your work from the sample test, doesn't advise strategies) Chapter 6 The Learning Express Test Preparation Systems (i.e. the author's recommendation to preparing for the test, make a schedule, eat well ...all in 9 steps...skip) Chapter 7 AFOQT and 11 sections and answers Chapter 8 AFAST 5 sections and answers Chapter 9 ASTB 5 sections and answers Additional Online Practice Once again, not a guide to help you develop specific strengths in a certain test section, just a measuring tool to see where you are.
