Being an "old Marine wife" the pictures that are shown brought tears to my eyes, so many deployment memories; thank you for the F-18's! When anyone enlists or marries into the military you do so as an adult and have a decent idea of what you may encounter, regardless of MOS. Never once has a child born into the military asked to be a Brat. They have the hardest job in the military. How do you explain to a three year old her daddy is somewhere and sees the same moon each night? And this was 25 years ago when there was no Goodnight Marines to help me! To this day the two of us look at the moon and know that the other is thinking about the other. Thank you for FINALLY helping the little ones to understand where their Marine is! Semper Fi and may your heart feel the hope you are giving to our "Marine Brats!" (They really should have their own MOS!)

This is a great book! It covers a wide variety of military occupations in its storyline. The illustrations are beautiful as well. The book also covers some Marine Corps history offering definitions of terms seen throughout the book. And of course, it wouldn't be complete without the Marines Hymn at the end of the story. A must have for Marines and all service members who want to give a special gift to their little ones before they deploy. I myself have been in the USMC for a little over 19 years now, and have seen the pain in little ones' eyes when their mommy or daddy is being shipped off overseas to do what they do best.
