

Significantly less detail than previous Lonely Planet guides to the Caribbean

Meh.

Nice book except we were planning a trip to Bonaire and they had very few pages to help.

I didn't find this as useful as I do most Lonely Planet books. It's possibly trying to cover too much area in too little space. There's a little info about the things you're actually in a place to see, but it's mostly hotel and restaurant listings, which were completely useless to me. I want to see pictures, reviews, and details of all the things there are to do/see, not the hotels I can stay at.

It really is worthless, I shouldn't have ignored the other reviews

The Discover Caribbean Islands travel guide is the worst Lonely Planet guide I have purchased. The information on the islands is shallow and superficial, and apparently written for the least curious of the sailing crowd. There is little written on the different cultures of the islands, their unique history, or ecology. Every island offers every Caribbean experience one would want - a hyperbole that is repeated again and again for every island. This book undermines the usual consistency and content of Lonely Planet guides.

I ordered this and Fodor's Caribbean 2015 at the same time to compare. Specifically I was looking for information on the Cayman Islands. This book only had about 6 pages, basically worthless. I realize the Cayman's are not always considered part of the caribbean, but, still. Fodor's had about 30 pages on the Cayman Islands, and overall is about 3 times the size (over 1,000 pages). This book was only a few hundred pages. Just not enough information in this one to justify keeping them

both. Returned.

There are much better guides for the Caribbean. I highly recommend Fodors
