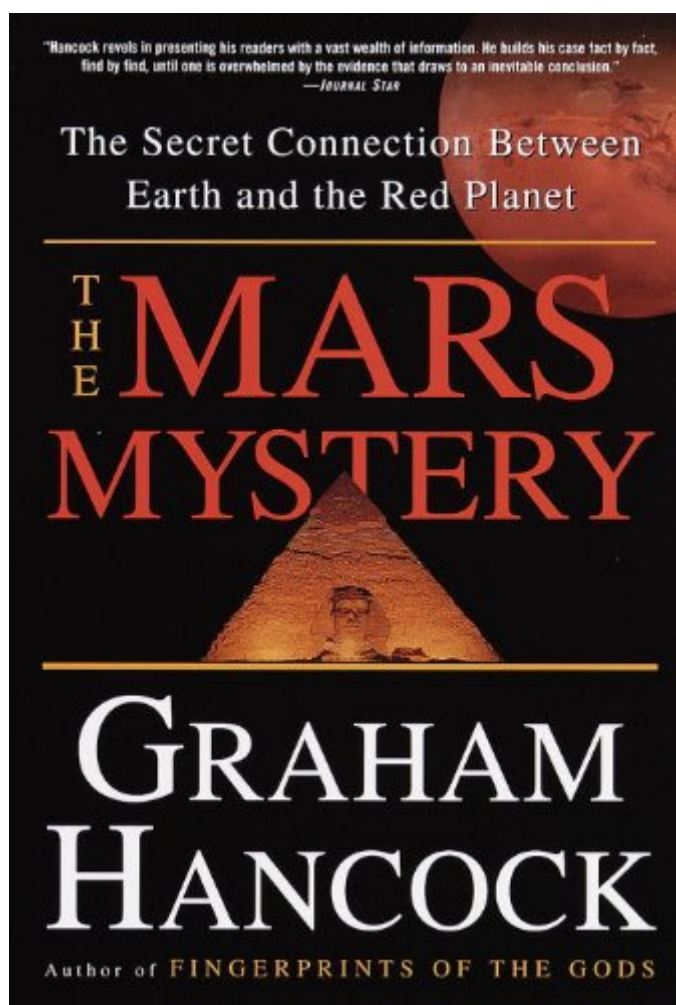

The problem with all these Mars books citing ancient civilizations and the Face on Mars is this: The evidence is pure speculation based on photographs that cannot be trusted as physical evidence. The Viking search for life results and atmospheric readings help but are themselves inconclusive. The book gets a 5 for content and effort. And it is worth reading but with full critical faculties engaged.

Not at all dated, this is a carefully researched treatment. I feel more attracted to Tom VanFlandern's Exploded Planet Hypothesis as the best explanation for Mars' obliteration, but Hancock does an excellent job of putting forth the comet impact theory alternative. He's a careful researcher and an exceptionally lucid science writer.

An incredible talent is Hancock to have the eye to recognize the strange, mysterious and out of place! Hancock IS a scholar of scholars!

Another excellent work by the author. Mr Hancock is an excellent and interesting writer. He writes in great depth so you can understand the who, what, when, where, how and why of his research and opinions. This book is typical to his writing in that regard. If you are knowledgeable on what he has written the books may cover a lot of ground you have trod in previous times. If you however are a novice in his field of research, you will be amazed at the amount of information he conveys. It is definitely another pass around book!

I enjoy learning about things that aren't covered in the mainstream media. This is the third book I've read by Graham Hancock and he fits the bill. I continue to be impressed by the way he builds his case and then presents his evidence like a world class attorney with great writing skills to boot. One of my favorite authors..

There's more to Mars than we know. This opens the door.

Hancock draws parallels between structures found on Mars with those in Egypt - pyramids, a giant Sphinx-like face, etc. Well-illustrated.

There are many mysteries on both Mars and Earth which strongly suggest that intelligent life existed on both planets and that the monuments on Mars and those on Earth were likely built by the same intelligence and for important purposes. This is a great read.
