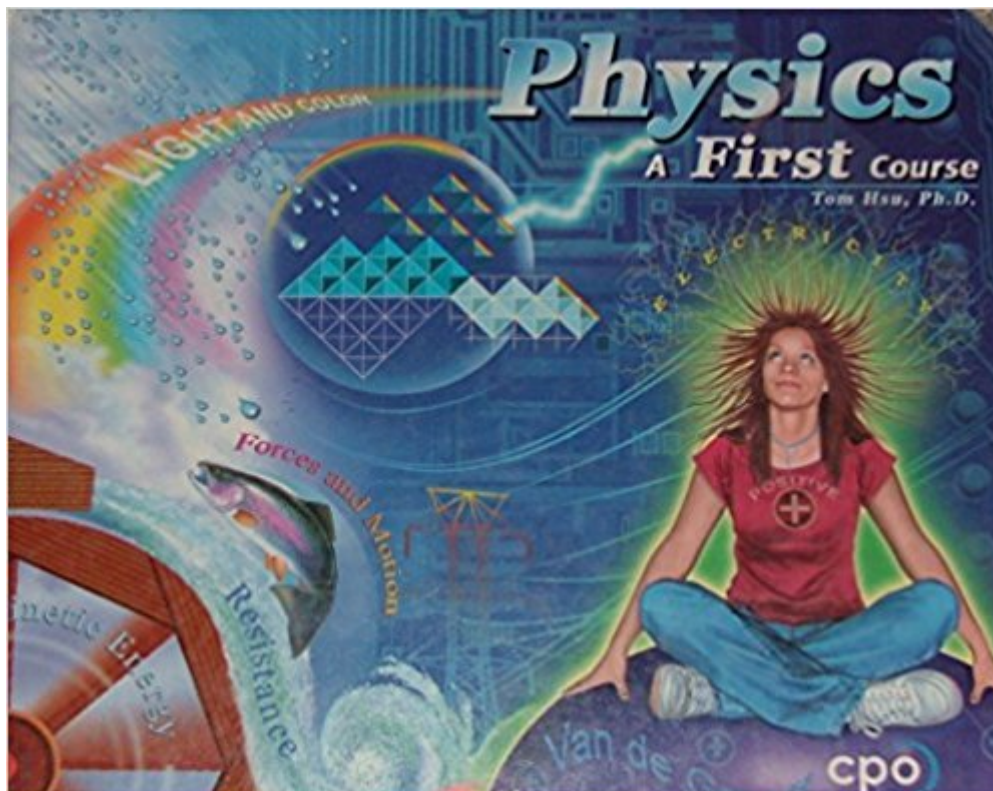

Unit 1 Chapter 1 Sentence 1 Mistakes 2 "On June 21, 2004, SpaceShipOne became the first private aircraft to leave Earth's atmosphere and enter space" Not one but two mistakes in the first sentence of the book. A vehicle that flies into space is a spacecraft not an aircraft. SpaceShipOne did not leave the Earth's atmosphere. It barely reached the upper mesosphere and lower thermosphere. There is not a magical balloon in the sky that says inside is atmosphere and outside is space. The properties of the atmosphere up there are so dynamic that you can't tell much about where the layers are. You can say that space is the invisible line at 100 km altitude = 62.3 miles = 328 000 feet (look at SpaceShipOne's tail number - hint, hint) which is what the International Federation of Astronautics defines space to be. It is an altitude and has nothing to do with atmosphere. Altitude. The book lost most of its credibility after the first 17 words. Maybe I will look at it again while I am studying for my teaching certificate exams. See how many more mistakes I can find. And why am I so nit picky? Because I worked on SpaceShipOne.
