

(Statements like, "Practitioners opening their own business will be influenced by their financial situation and tolerance of risk." are a prime example of common sense text I didn't need to spend time on.) Often too wordy. It is easy to read, but the material is dry. The book is a large, heavy paperback and after light use is falling apart at the binding. Finally, this book, like all textbooks, is overpriced.
