

Very nice coffee table book, good layout, pretty photos. I purchased this after a vacation to Napa/Sonoma and wine tasting in this region. I saw this book at one of the wineries and liked it, but did not end up purchasing it. Regretted that after the fact and searched for it on (where it was priced \$7.00 less than the winery). Great saving!!

I was so surprised that many major wineries were not even included in this book. Chateau Montelena, which was instrumental for the recognition of Napa Valley as an internationally recognized wine producing area by winning the Paris Wine Competition in 1976, was not included. This leave one to wonder if the wineries listed paid for the publication to be profiled in the book. The internet may be a better source of information.

We recently visited Napa and enjoyed the book that was in our room at the Westin Verasa Napa. It looked exactly like this book so we bought what we thought was the same book. Unfortunately, this book contains less information. It does a fine write-up of the wineries they decided to include, but since we saw a better more complete version this one is just OK to us.

A beautiful book with fantastic recommendations. We've gone wine tasting before but often ended up visiting tasting rooms with poor quality wines or styles not to our taste. This guide helped us choose vineyards that made our favorite wines. Easy to follow directions with detailed maps. Stunning photos of each winery. Great book at a low price.
