

We have a few items from this series of graphic biographies, and they are uniformly good -- good writing and excellent artwork. The books do an especially good job at showing the historical, social,

and emotional context of what is happening. So, in addition to learning about events in the life of Martin Luther King, Jr., kids really get a sense of how much was at stake -- how much fear and hatred and ignorance were out there, and how much courage it took to do what he did. The book presents the information in a way that's compelling and interesting to kids (and to adults as well). My 7-year-old couldn't put this one down, and it led to a lot of really interesting discussions afterward -- about how things have changed, about things that people are fighting for today, etc. We ended up looking up some of Dr. King's speeches online so she could learn more. We also have the Jackie Robinson and Rosa Parks biographies from the same series. Although all three of these books are excellent, I thought that -- of these three -- the Rosa Parks one is the best. It has a lot of detail and really does her story justice.

This is a great read. My daughter enjoyed the art work and the commentary. I've purchased more of these graphic novels since.
