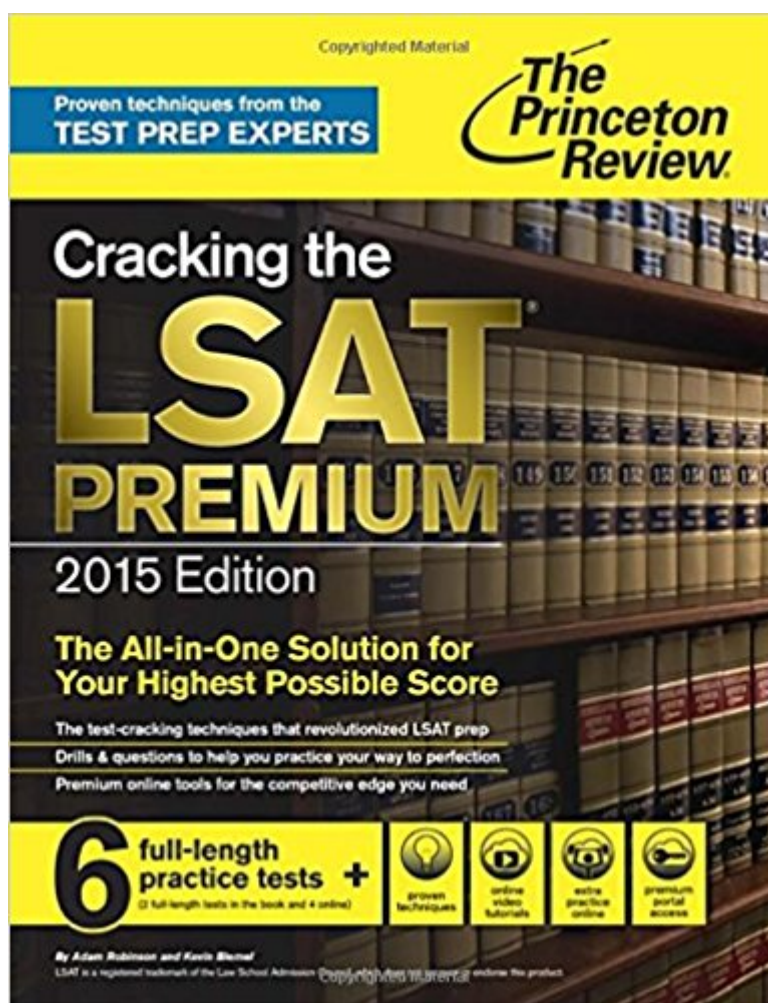

Do you want a quality overview and techniques for every section of the LSAT? Then get this. Do you

want awesome tips and advice for the law school process and applying? Then get this. Do you want an average score between a 150-160? Then get this. Do you want score beyond 160? Then you need something else or something more. It seems like this book is good for getting you to do well on the LSAT. However, if you want to do excellently you are going to need more help. After working through the whole book I still felt like I was not getting the results I wanted, specifically on logic games. I then picked up Powerscore's Logic Games Bible. I wish I had started with it since it goes through the fundamentals soooo much better than Cracking the LSAT. Bottom Line: If you have more than 8 weeks, then get the trilogy of Powerscore's Bibles. If you have 8 weeks or less, then get this since you won't have enough time for much more. Hope this helps!

Prior to purchasing this edition, I have reviewed so many LSAT study guides that so many authors have written in explaining or discovering ways to conquer the LSAT. Moreover, I think all of them have unique techniques, but I was going for the techniques that I felt was going to be useful for my type of learning style. Because of that, I selected this edition and I am very glad I selected this edition which is 2015 edition because obviously it's updated in terms of what is likely to be on LSAT for today versus what LSAT was like in 1998 or 2001, for example. Overall, with the many editions that are out on the market, to make a decision on which edition or which author gave the best methodology in conquering the LSAT, one would have to select the author that is best suitable for his or her learning style. For me, it would be this 2015 edition.
