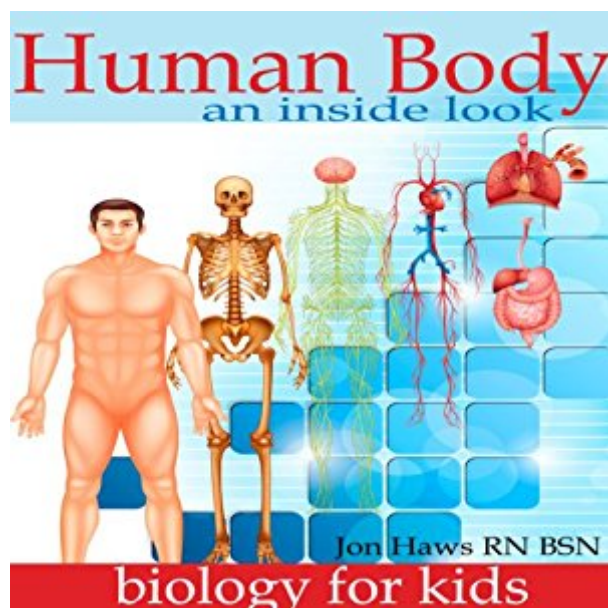

Fabulous teaching tool! I like that all parts are labeled and then there is a real picture. It was easy for 2nd graders to learn and a wonderful tool for them to reference on their own when they have questions about their bodies.

This is a very good book with a lot of in-depth information about human anatomy. I took off a star because I don't believe that the age range for ages 5 - 18 / good for grades 3 to 12 is accurate. The subtitle "biology for kids" would lead a would-be reader to believe that this is made for elementary

school kids which isn't the case at all. I tested a few passages from the book on various readability scoring websites. Flesch Kincaid scores as well as other readability tests scored various passages anywhere from 8th grade up through 12th grade. I'd recommend this text more for junior high or high school students. Average readers in the elementary school years may find the book too challenging though very advanced readers may enjoy it.
