

I bought one for each of my kids, ages 5 and 9. It was a very easy read for my 9 year old, but this is the first Bible she has owned and wanted it in the simplest terms for her to start out. Both kids loved it and it answered a lot of questions they had.

The letter font is a great size and good matching illustrations. The book is great and I like the way the bible stories are presented, but I was disappointed in the size. It's a small book and is a bit difficult to read with your baby in your lap and reading the book in front of your baby. The book would be awesome if it was larger and easier to handle with little one.

Kenneth Taylor's children's Bible is a nice introduction of the Bible. It isn't the best one, but it is one I'd keep as a switch from whatever your go-to version is. That's what I do. My boy is now five and bored with this edition. The illustrations are nothing special, reminding me of picture Bibles from the 1960s, the kind I'd see in the dentist office. Their cliche nature offers nothing to add to the book. The text is too simple to even develop a story, glossing over even basic theology.
