The *first* book I got for \$1.99 -- and that was about the right price. For all the additional books (and there are several) it's \$8 plus... The first book is about the young Mia, and every female can identify with her. By the third book, it's all about her first crush, and, for example, that means more than 2 pages that only repeat the same sentence over, and over, and over, and over... The books are also

dated, since they are interspersed with "real" characters the "Princess" meets. I haven't bothered to finish the last one I bought, and she's still in 7th grade.

What a great series! Mia is a socially concious, vegetarian teen with all the trials of being a teenager. While she's not very popular and not very pretty, she has every girl's fantasy as her own reality: she's a princess. The best part of these books is that through Mia's eyes we can see what a pain in the butt being famous royalty must be! In the past two books Ms. Cabot dealt with Mia's discovery that she was a princess, her Grandmother's "Princess Lessons", her Mother's pregnancy and subsequent marriage to Mia's Algebra teacher and Mia's settling into her role in the spotlight. In this book we get to see how Mia deals with her "love life". Mia's comments on life are witty and touching. Also, this is NOT a book that talks down to teen-age readers. All the situations (besides that of Mia being a princess from some small unkown country) are realistic and this book depicts rather accuarately what it's like to be in High School and how to survive it! I laughed out loud a lot and could see the funnier side of some of my own high school traumas. Ms. Cabot writes these books as though they are actually Mia's diaries which can sometimes be very distracting. There are often "homework" assignments and other things written at the bottoms of pages which I could have done without. So for that I took a star off of my rating. Still, I definately reccomend these books not just for the 12-15 range, but for us older people as well. They are well written and just plain fun to read. And they each leave you wanting more. I can't wait to get my hands on the next installment in Mia's new life as a princess!

I got PIL in the mail yesterday and finished it late last night. I was not dissappointed. It is just as good as Princess Diaries and better than Princess In the Spotlight. It follows only a few weeks of

Mia's life, but they are a busy few weeks that give the reader much of what we were longing for in the second book. If you read the others, you MUST read this one. Mia learns a lot in this book, and sees that adults aren't exactly the cruel beings she often perceives them to be. I think she grows a lot more in this book than in the previous two, and liked her more and more with each page. Don't get me wrong, she's still witty, sassy and completely preoccupied with her social life, but she seems to be more 'self-actualized' :)BTW, there is (according to the authors website) a fourth book (Princess in Waiting) due out Spring of 2003, with more books to follow!

I've read all the previous books in the 'Princess Diaries' series and this one wasn't a disappointment, quality-wise. The plot was strong and I applaud Meg Cabot for not making the romantic subplot too corny. I will say that the ending is a bit unrealistic and I'm somewhat suspicious of the guy she ends up with...but I won't elaborate further because it'd spoil the ending. So read it for yourself and maybe you'll get what I'm talking about. It's a funny book, something I could bring and read at my high school without being embarrassed.
