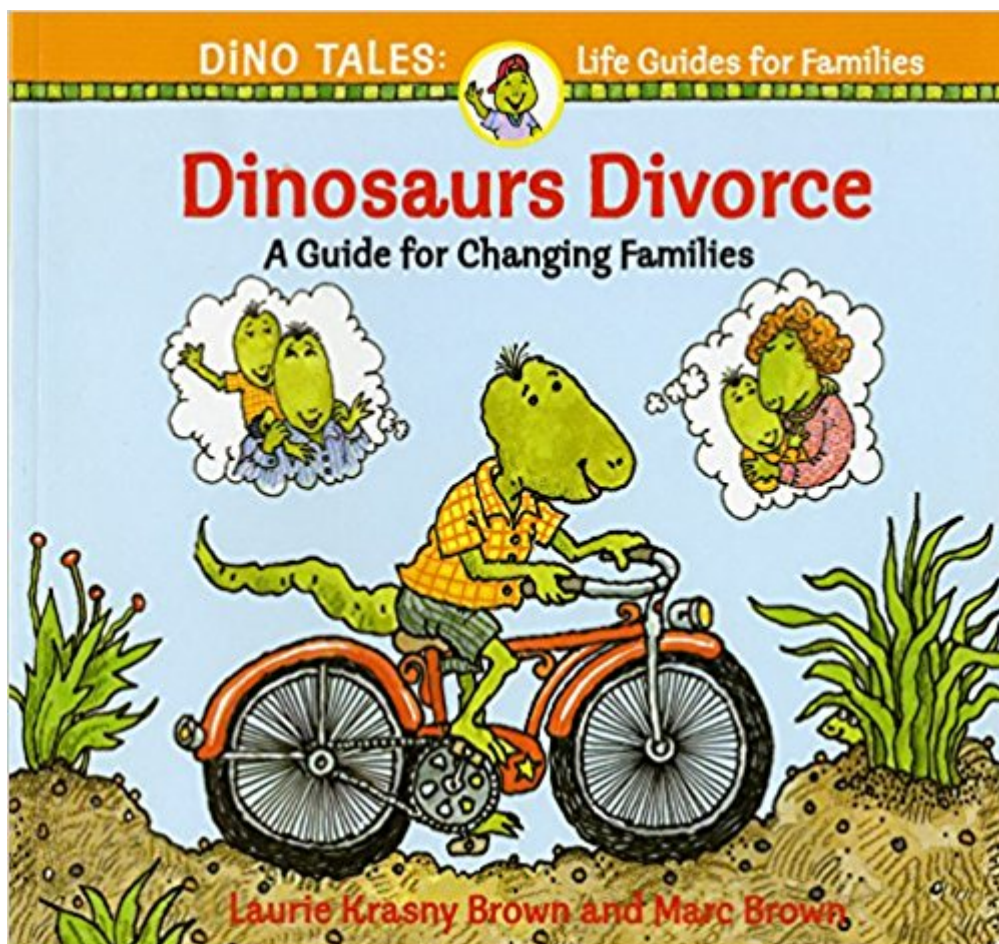

(Done with her mother's permission BTW) I recommend buying it and reading it through, and using the parts that you feel will work best for your child. It DOES provide good ideas and thought processes. And, for some children, just reading it makes a lot of sense. It's worth buying. These are tough conversations and this helps.

Was helpful in explaining to my son about our divorce. It covers some topics, like drugs and alcohol I don't think were appropriate for a 6 year old. I actually covered some parts with paper and tape some pages together to get the point across without showing the parts that I didn't feel were necessary.

I have found it useful for young children whose parents are going through a divorce they don't understand.

We chose this book to help our young daughters understand divorce when the time came to tell them we were splitting. It has helped so much to be able to read it to them again as needed to explain it.
