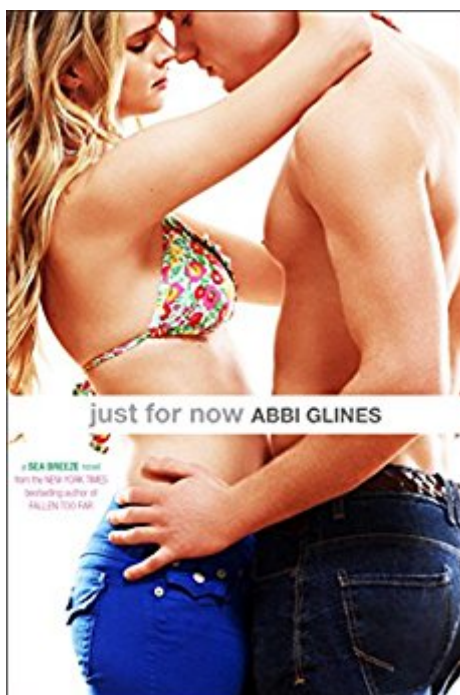

Couple of hang-ups with this book - the first is that in YA, it is difficult for an adult author to strike the right chord with dialogue, especially for male characters. Too often I see authors go way too far into slang territory - making characters who sound like caricatures of themselves. But this book has the opposite problem - multiple teenage characters sound ridiculously old and/or formal. Like this author has never spoken to an actual teen before. Having several teens in my life, I can promise you that not one of them sounds like Sadie, Jax or Marcus. This is also something I'd never give to a teen girl, given how explicit the "love" scenes are. When Sadie gets her very first kiss, it quickly escalates into a Very Adult situation. Which made me sad for her that she didn't get any stages in her courtship - just straight to the extreme physical. The author never managed to convince me that the teens were actually in love, rather it plays like a case of extreme lust. It was okay. I didn't actively hate it, but I'm not interested in continuing on with this series. Just didn't really enjoy it.

Sadie is hired on at The Stone's place as a maid. Jax Stone is the hottest teen rock sensation. Isn't looking for commitment, but when he eyes Sadie he must have her. Sadie isn't looking for a summer fling. While this book is full of cliché's and it's not a work of literary genius, it is entertaining. They are just the perfect book for spring or summer beach reads. A little racy, a little silly, and a whole lot of swoon worthiness.

Preston has been the playboy (yep, another one!) in the background of all the other Sea Breeze books. He plays baseball with Cage and he is Marcus's best friend. Amanda is Marcus's little sister who has had a crush on Preston for years. Now she is old enough to act on her feelings. "Sometimes the answer we need is in our heart. We just have to listen to it." This book is filled with family secrets, secret love, and just plain ole secrets. Preston has a whole separate life that nobody knows about. Not even his closest friends. Getting involved with Amanda could threaten to expose everything he had worked so hard to keep secret, but can he resist he? He also knows that Marcus would never allow it to happen. "But when we find that one person who completes us, we don't give up. No matter how bad we screwed up. We make it right." As Preston and Amanda get closer to each other, it becomes harder for them to hide their feelings from their friends and harder for Preston to hide his other life from Amanda. When it all comes out, can they get past it all? I felt like I was a fly on the wall of their secret love story. "I love you with a scary, insane, wild, amazing love. I always will. No one else could ever make me feel this way." "I love you. I love you so damn
