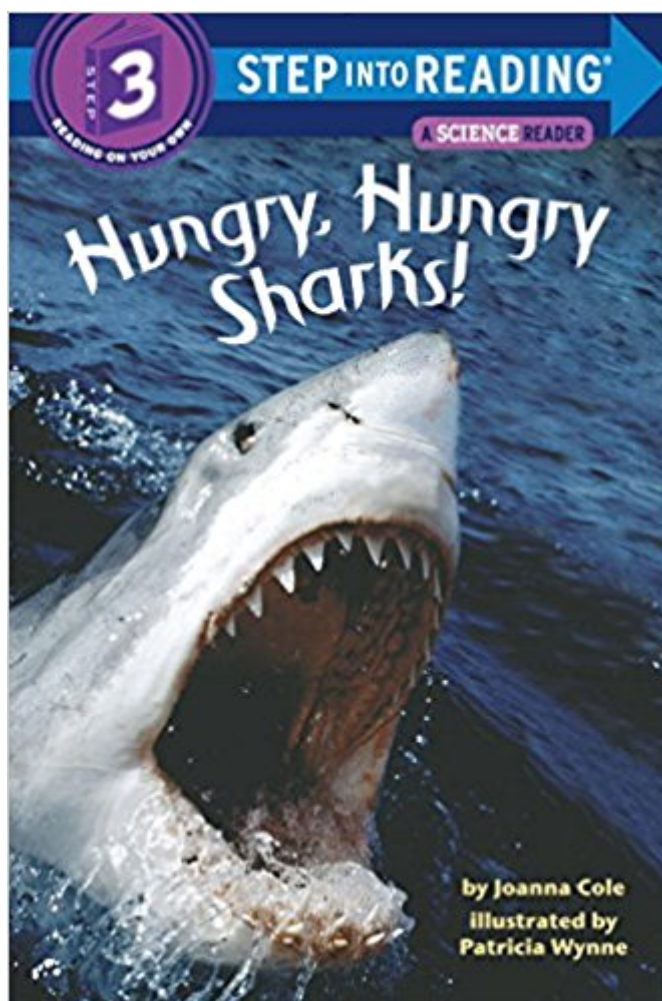

I think this has been dis-proven. It also doesn't address the problem of sharks being killed for their fin or because people don't like them and how they are becoming endangered. None of that info is in the book. In fact it says they have been here since dinosaur time and they will always be here. But other than that it does have enough info for my 4 year old who loves to learn about animals. It has drawings instead of photos. It shows different types of sharks. The book touches on the subject of sharks attacking people without being gory. This book says all kinds of non food has been found inside sharks. Actual items found are MINK coat, treasure chest of jewels, suit of armor, barrel of nails. This is our favorite part.

My son is currently 6 years old and in 1st grade. He was able to read 98% of this book on his own (a little easier than expected). He was very interested in this book and it did a good job breaking down the point without going into too much depth which would take away his interest.

I got mix of 2-3-4 levels for the second grader, second level is too easy, but it creates some fun and he reads them with pleasure. Love it, I would recommend it.
