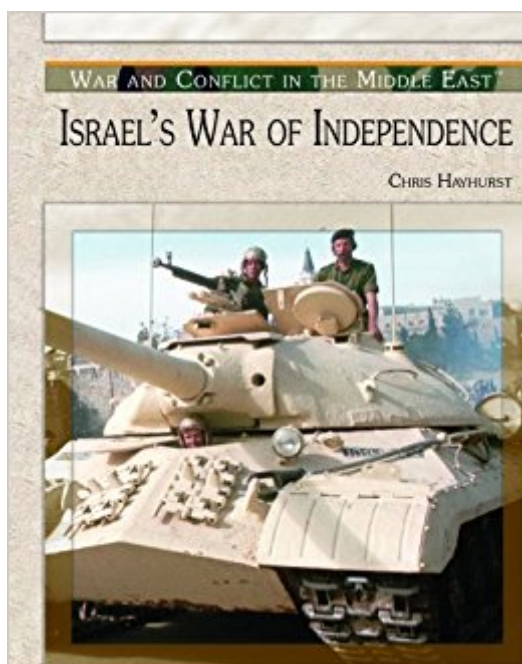

Reviewed with Katherine Wingate's *The Intifadas*. Gr. 5-9. Part of the War and Conflict in the Middle East series, these titles provide fair, well-balanced accounts of the history and ongoing fighting between Israelis and Palestinians. Hayhurst discusses how Israel became a country, beginning with the declaration of independence in 1948 and the war that set off more than 50 years of violence. Wingate focuses on how the Palestinians lost their land and how the Palestinians in occupied territories retaliated. Both Hayhurst and Wingate call for negotiation and compromise, and Wingate sees hope in the peace organizations that work with young people. The series design is spacious, with clear type, lots of well-captioned news photos, up-to-date statistics, maps, and occasional boxed profiles of important leaders. A glossary, a bibliography, and a list of organizations to contact are appended, but there are no notes. There's a lot to spark discussion, especially if the books are read together.
