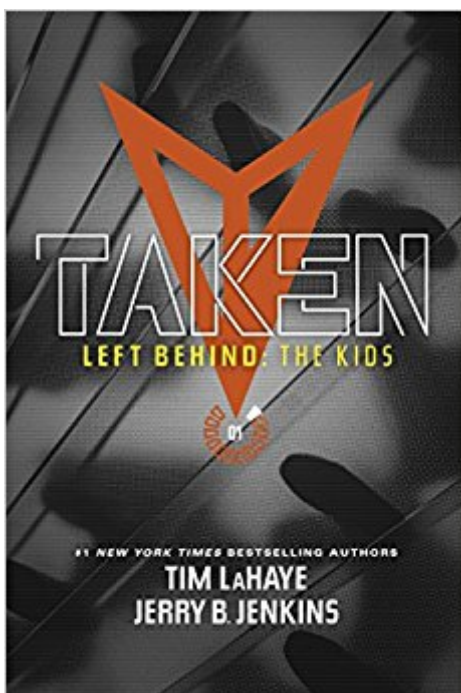

It's neat that the authors made a second Left Behind Story, not a replacement or remake, but a story that parallels the main series. I think the title however is somewhat misleading, because it's not about children, the main characters are all teenagers or older (except for one who's 12 at the start). I think a more accurate title would've been "Left Behind Teenagers". It's really neat the way that the Left Behind series covers the rapture and other future events. And it kind of gives it a whole new feeling to have it experienced by younger people. It gets quite emotional, especially since they all basically become orphans. Having already read the main Left Behind Series, I find it neat the way that the authors sort of interwove this new story into it, sometimes using existing characters from the first series. Sometimes it kind of makes it feel like your reading details that were left out the first time. Though this series may be geared towards younger people, I really don't think that it's any different than the main series. The main characters are younger, but the events are really no less intense, sometimes I almost think that it's even more. In some of the later books of this series, I think they go a little too far. I'm 33 years old, but overall I like the Left Behind Kids series just as much as the main series, if not more.

This book is not my favourite book in the world, but I gave it five stars because you have to read this book to understand the rest of the series, and the rest of the series is AMAZING! Would recommend this series. If this review was helpful then please mark as helpful. Thanks.
