Her career has been spent as an educator teaching students with learning difficulties and working as an elementary school principal and educational consultant. As much as she has enjoyed her work as an educator, nothing can compare to her job as a mother of triplets and then one more! Her children were the inspiration for her first novel Triple Trouble Plus One and continue to have a voice in this second novel in the series--Maddie Hoffman Gymnastics Superstar. As a child psychotherapist, I ordered this book upon recommendation from a colleague. Sometimes I will use literature to facilitate conversation about a child's worries and concerns. For some children, it's much easier for them to talk about a "problem" that a story character is experiencing rather than talking about themselves. For example, this book provides a wonderful opportunity to talk about bullying, and the author does a beautiful job of illuminating this issue in a sensitive way. The book is written so that children not only read the story, but they're given the opportunity (at the end of some chapters) to express their thoughts and make predictions on what will happen next. By doing this, the author invites the reader to take an active role in processing the story content by pausing to make predictions. The story itself is simply wonderful and filled with family dynamics that will resonate for lots of young readers. I hope that Diane C. Wander will continue to write more novels about this unique family!

Loved Maddie Hoffman! It's a charming story full of insights and very entertaining. I read it wearing two hats--grandma of a gymnast, and elementary school teacher. It gets A+ from both departments. The interactive format of making predictions is very engaging to the young reader. And the passion and problems shared by the characters are universal in nature. That's why I make the prediction that this book will be enjoyed and loved by all who read it.
