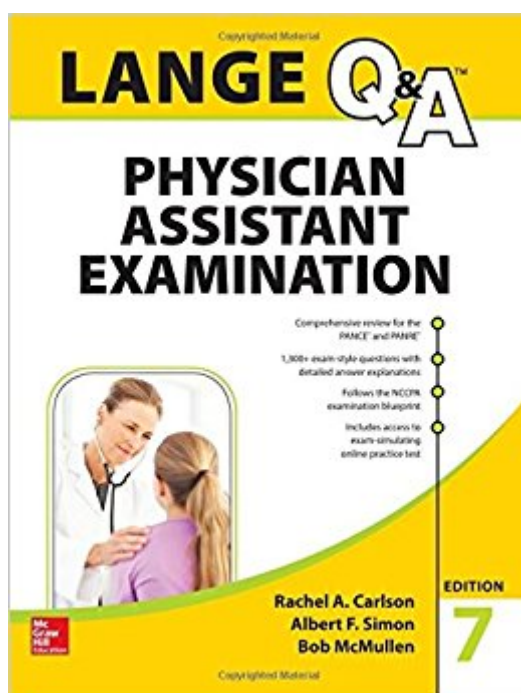

I had the older version to study from during PA school, but since this came out a few months before my boards I decided to upgrade. The questions themselves are super helpful, ranging from easy to quite challenging...and always relevant. However, I gave it only 4 stars because some of the answers in the back are wrong! There were a few that I just couldn't understand why the answer would be what is listed and I took it to my professors and clinicians who all agreed there were mistakes. This can be very frustrating during such a stressful time. Hopefully they will come out with a new version soon to edit the incorrect answers.

I am about 50 % through the book and so frustrated with the errors. Every chapter so far has a couple, if not several, wrong answers-the letter choice does not match the description in the "Answers and Explanations" section. Makes it challenging to check my work, and I've completely lost confidence in what I am reading in this book. I've been doing this for nearly 20 years, and I'm embarrassed that this is the best work that these people can produce. Glad I have a back up

Plenty of good questions but not sure any effort was put forward in editing. Multiple questions where answer didn't match up with multiple choice letter. Seriously, how hard is it to make sure they match. Hopefully no one is misled to incorrect answer because of this

I would have given a higher review as I think the practice and information is extremely helpful, however, the Dermatology section provides horribly inadequate pictures that are black and white (THIS IS DERM, COLOR IS CRITICAL) and so far I've found an incorrect answer key to one of the

questions. Other than that the supplementary information provided along with the correct answer (assuming it's right) is extremely helpful when learning to decipher between conditions.

There was no CD, DVD with this book and the link to the computer practice exam questions was not great at all, not that many questions and faulty computer program/web-site. Also, the web-site practice questions were doubled up over different subjects resulting in repeat questions numerous times. Book returned...very dissatisfied.

Although this book is helpful to test myself while studying for my clinical medicine class, there were numerous times where the multiple choice answers were listed incorrectly and did not correspond to the explanation, making it difficult and confusing to figure out what the correct answer was. Furthermore, my book came with many ink splashes throughout, that caused pages to stick together, and would tear and disrupt the text when separated.

This edition had so many errors!!! What is the point of a study guide if the answers are listed incorrectly? Orthopedics had the majority of the errors. For the money I spent on this book, you would think an editor could've done a better job editing! This guide also was of NO use with my current PANRE.

When I received this book, I opened it to a random page and picked a question. The explanation/answer was not correct, as mentioned in previous posts. I used a previous edition of this book to study for my initial certification several years ago and noticed an error or two, but this edition is much worse. What a shame.
