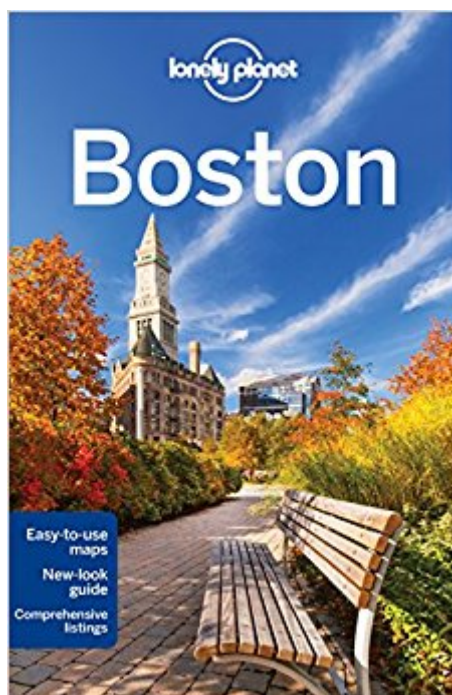

Absolutely excellent guide to Boston. We spend five days there and with this guide (as well as cross checking with TripAdvisor), couldn't be happier with our lodging, meals, and sightseeing. I have come to trust these guides and will always buy Lonely Planet if it's available for the location we are going to. It is dense and requires some studying ahead of time to get the most out of it, but well worth the time invested. It gives information on itineraries based on the number of days you have, places to stay (with pros and cons of the area as well as the individual lodgings), suggested places to eat with the number one suggestion for the area highlighted. Just as an example, we followed the suggestion of the best place to eat in Little Italy and couldn't have been more pleased. There are so many restaurants there that it can be overwhelming, but we knew right where we wanted to go and made reservations ahead of time.
