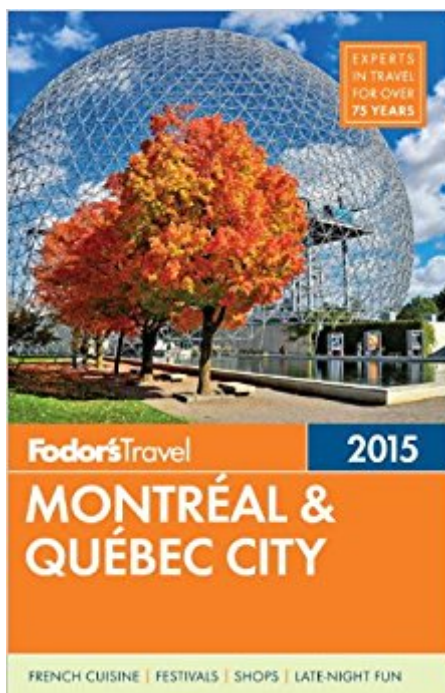

This is a good guidebook in that it has what you would expect to find in a guidebook -- suggestions of where to go and what to see, and descriptions of sights, hotels, and restaurants. Hours, pricing, website addresses, etc. One thing that was missing from this guide was any mention of where to park when going to the sights or restaurants. Also, we found that the map that comes with the guide is not very useful. You are better off getting a map from the Tourist Office once you arrive in

Montreal or Quebec City, or purchase one at a gas station.

The best maps in the city of Montreal. In the hotel/restaurant reviews they missed quite a few good restaurants. I felt that they should have added more. They obviously did not like the Latin Quarter, which has the students, and is "artsy". We loved it! Great food, interesting people. Very good book over all.

Just returned from Quebec and found this guide useful and up-to-date. I did cut out all the Montreal pages to make it about 1/3 the weight and size it was when new. I know...that seems dumb but I wanted to keep the weight down and have something easy to access for walking around. Anyway, if I go to Montreal I'll just stuff the additional pages in my bag. Anyway, this guide provided plenty of information for our 4 day visit without overwhelming with useless information. BTW, if you haven't been to Quebec, it is a most beautiful and unique place...really like being in a small city in France where everyone is friendly and speaks both French and English. It's very accessible from the USA but be prepared to walk up and down streets with hills. Don't forget to take this guidebook with you.

It had great information about certain attractions, but I found the map very difficult to use. It would have also helped to have a map of all the underground stores and locations. I had a very difficult time navigating this city

I travel extensively and this book is a waste of money. When I purchase the newest edition, 2015, I expect it to be up to date. It is not. Fodor's state "At this writing, the exchange rate is US \$ 1 to C \$ 1.05, nearly at par." On Jan 1, 2015, the CAD was .86 to the USD. This kind of bad information can get a traveler in trouble. I have numerous other issues with this travel guide. I expect a travel guide to be a one stop shop. As of the date of this review, the e book is more expensive than the paperback price is \$15.15 while the e book price is \$15.99. An e book is cheaper to distribute yet has the advantage that the publisher can change errors immediately. The book did

contain useful information it has enough problems that I have to go on the web to find information I need before making a final decision. It is anemic on public transportation. When it lists an area or restaurant, they do NOT give you the closest bus or metro station. This is vital when traveling. Again you have to get on the web to find this data. I expect the guide to contain a bus and metro map. It doesn't
