He is a king, royalty, and is expected to marry a princess or another noble, someone of his class. Madeline is a servant and obviously not of that stature. They love each other, they know it, and are powerless to do anything about it. I loved the story line. I wanted to see how they were going to pull this off. The author was dropping hints of what is to come and unfortunately, decided to drop it into yet another tawdry novel. Honestly, I should have bought the book that was sex-free. I'm not a prude, but this was packed with lewd, tawdry, ugly sex. I so wish the author would have left out the verbal sound effects. The sex scenes were monotonous, overdone, and offensive. It ruined the entire book for me and I won't be buying anymore of this author's work. I've read some real smut in my life, but this was just too much. Way too much. I do believe that too much sex or poorly written sex scenes can destroy a story and sadly, this is what happened here. Aside from that, the book needs to see an editor for a checkup. the lack of historical accuracy, terminology, and poor editing, then move along to something else. However, if you can forget all that and just get into the story, I recommend this book. I am just discovering romance books, but know I like "historical" - though I prefer dashing knights- and paranormal. I do not care to get a history lesson. I do not care about accurate facts. I care about the relationship and an interesting story, and this book does it for me. Honestly, I bought it to see how the sexy parts were written, but ended up getting involved in the whole story and have ordered the next two books. I like the King and feel for his struggle. I like Madeline and am desperate to find out what happens to her, her family history, and how her romance with the King ends. It had better be a happy ending. The editing errors do make it sometimes difficult to read, and I literally started making corrections and adding missing words for when I re-read, but I was invested enough in the story to muddle through.

This book had maybe a dozen or less very intense sex episodes. That in itself is OK but they were from four to eight pages each. How much of that could I read? The first two or three but after that they just became boring and repetitive so I skipped through them. The really laughable thing was that in each sexual episode the author had in caps AAAAAEEEEEEEEEOOOOO! EIIIEEEEEEEEEEE! AAAAAALLLEEEEEEXXX.....thought I was reading a super hero comic book.
