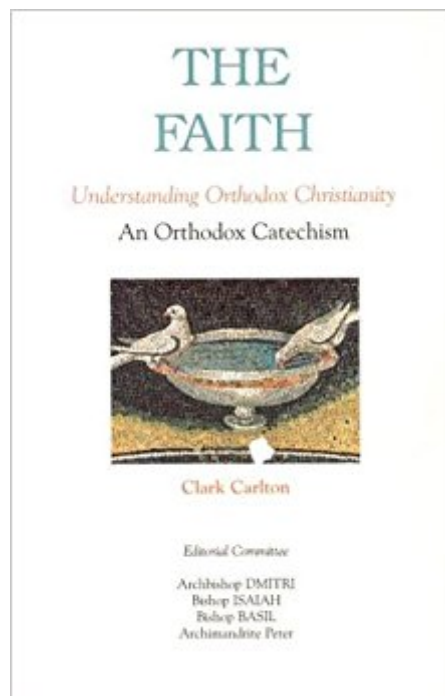

This book is an excellent introduction to the faith of Orthodox Christianity. The material is presented in an easy to digest manner that reads more as conversation than as a theological catechism. At the end of each chapter there is a page titled "Reflection" with questions about the preceding chapter. I don't really care for this "study guide" type format, but it seems that Carlton's intent is that this book

might be used in a class setting at some point and he has incorporated the reflection page for this purpose. I have read many other books that introduce the Orthodox Church and its beliefs but I haven't seen a better book than this for someone who is entering the Church and wants to understand the faith.
