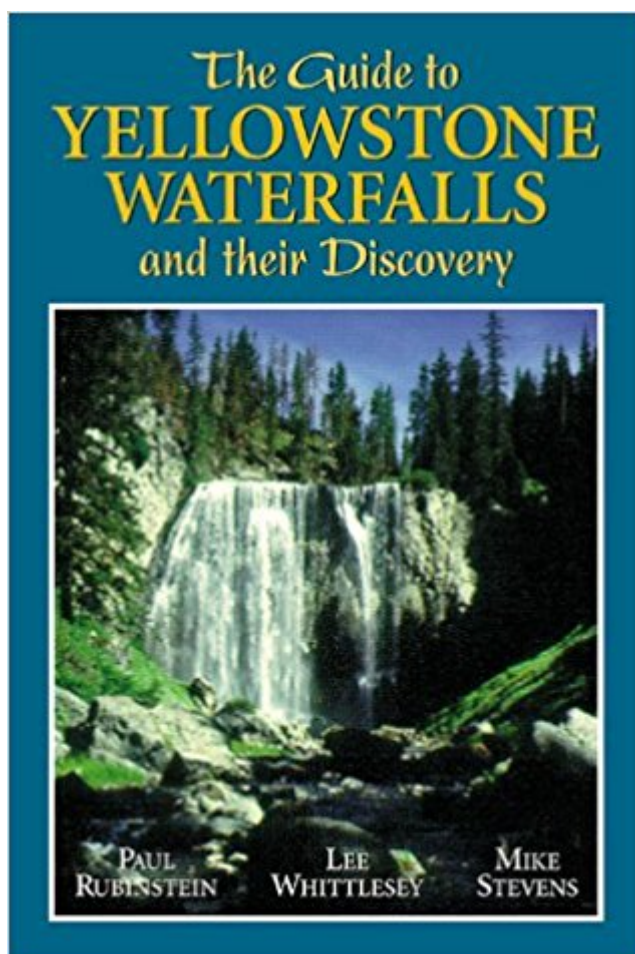

This is an amazing book. I've been to Yellowstone 12 times and have seen the usual list of waterfalls that are close to the roads many times. But last year we started to take day hikes and this book provides great incentive to do more of that to see some of the lesser known falls in the park. The sheer number of waterfalls pictured in this book that are located in the back country where there are no trails is amazing - some of which have only recently been discovered. The photos alone are worth the price of the book. This book is logically organized and well written with clear descriptions of the terrain and great directions for finding the falls. Highly recommended even for the armchair explorer who wants to know more about the hidden wonders of Yellowstone.

The authors of this book have tracked down, and provided color photos, of no less than 250 waterfalls in Yellowstone. While some were previously well known, many are new discoveries or re-discoveries of falls not seen in many years. That so many notable falls could occur in one area (even as large as Yellowstone) is remarkable; that so many significant falls could have remained to be discovered is downright mind-boggling. The authors provide interesting histories and excellent photos of each fall, and the book will be a joy to read and look at for any waterfall lover. My slight quibble is that while they provide coordinates and category of access for each fall, they don't provide directions or hiking distance. (In fairness, it can well be argued that if the information isn't readily available elsewhere for a given fall then the trek is one that should only be undertaken by a hardcore hiker.) Despite the quibble, this is a great book for any waterfall lover, and especially for one planning a trip to Yellowstone.

Have visited many of the falls listed over the years and have loved the way this book describes those I have been to and makes me excited to visit all of those which I will visit in the future. A real gem of a book. Wish it were still in print.
