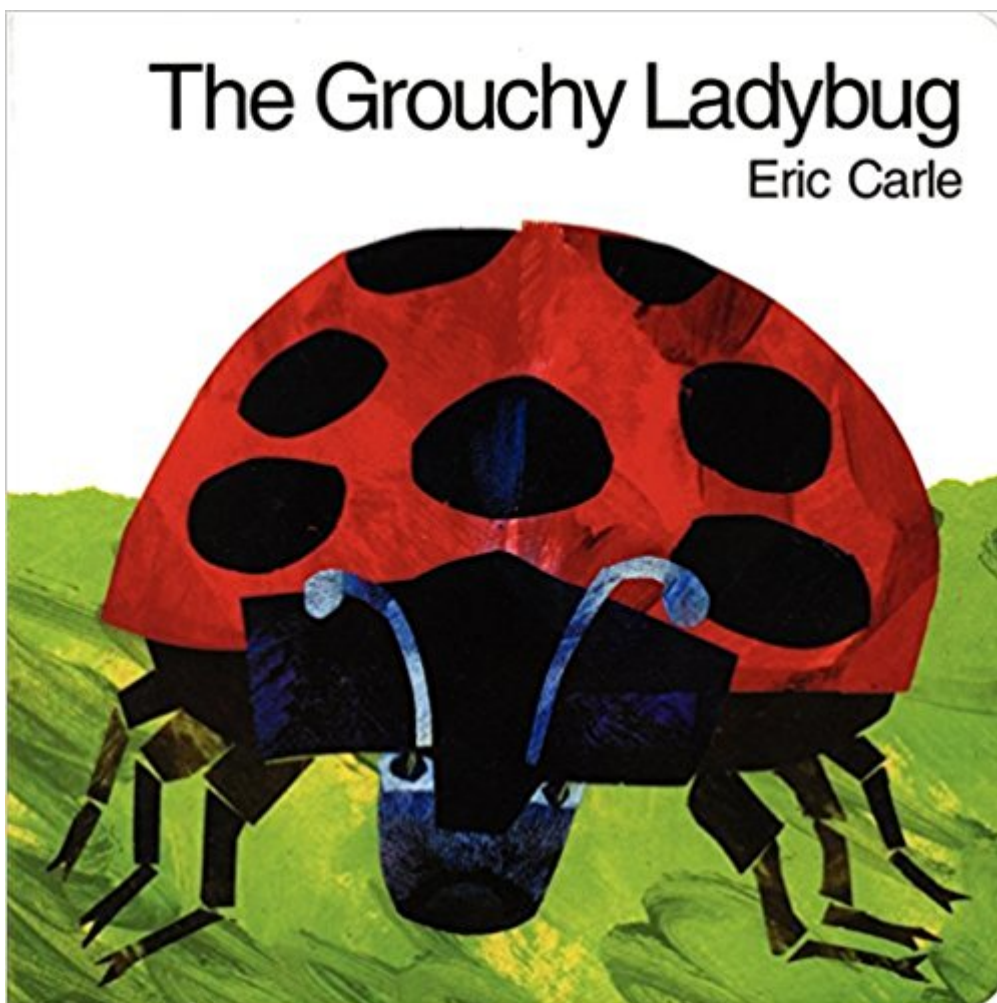

The storyline of this book is based on a grouchy ladybug asking every animal it encounters if it "wants to fight". I was expecting something better from Eric Carle, since The Very Hungry Caterpillar is an adorable, brightly colored read, but this was disappointing. If my son didn't love looking at each of the animals on the pages so much I would have returned it. It's too wordy and repeats the "want to fight?" question on every page, so we make a different story up as we go since my son is only 18 months. I would not recommend this book, and honestly, I would have returned it if I hadn't missed the deadline on returns.

This is one of the longest Eric Carle's books we have in our collection. It is perhaps more suitable for older children as my one year old daughter does not have the patience to sit through the entire story. That said, I personally enjoy the story as it has quite a few colorful characters. I also like the part where there was a page cut like a whales tail for you to flip and pretend to whip the lady bug across the sea.

You only have to share when forced by someone bigger than you? Eric Carle's illustrations are amazing as always, but wasted on this story. I'm returning the book.
