I am using this book for home school, as a backup to other science education that we cover. While not being equivalent to a "full course dinner" of science, this book to me is the equivalent of a "high quality daily multivitamin" of science, if that makes sense. It is very helpful and provides an easy way to learn and retain the information necessary for a broad overview of the subject, with a lot of specifics included. My son consistently scores very high on any science tests, and I will give this series credit for helping with that. Better off getting a text/workbook from AGS science and following chapter by chapter. I only bought this as sort of random filler for off days, and I still really don't even find it useful.

I did not find this book as good as the reviews indicated. It had little to no explanations for the questions that was asked. Not a very good book at all.

My 11 year old absolutely loves this book. He moved rapidly through Spectrum Science Grade 7, and is going more slowly through this one, since he wants to savor it.
