I have mixed feelings about this book after having a personal reading with Sonya. I think the book and Sonya are very comforting to those going through the loss of a pet. I almost wish I had not had a personal reading with Sonya after reading this book because it made me look at the book in a different light. While comforting, it also feels like marketing material. After reading the book and reading about these very specific readings Sonya has with her clients, and the amazing things she is able to tell them, you will want to schedule a reading yourself. Sonya even asked me if reading this book is what led me to scheduling a reading with her, and I bet it's giving her lots of business. But my reading was very different than the ones she talks about in the book, the things she told me were much more general and vague, and could apply to anyone who had lost a pet, and she didn't say anything that made me certain she was actually communicating with my animals. It made me wonder if this book is a bit of fiction, or at the very least, a collection of the few readings she's given that happen to very luckily hit the nail on the head. So do I recommend the book, sure. Do I think it's all legit, I'm not so sure.

I was dealing with the loss of my beautiful schnauzer, Baby. I read all the Biblical books, I read Rainbow Bridge, but I was still struggling.
