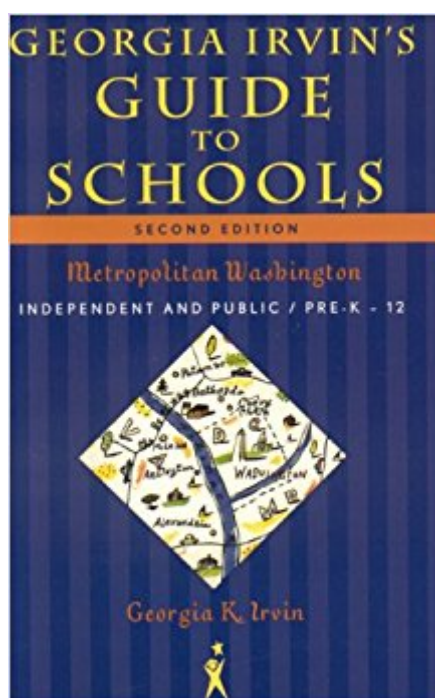

The rest of the book is a listing of schools and information on them. There is nothing in the listing that will give you rankings of the school nor recommendation so its just a reference and a list of all the schools. Most if not all the info you can get of the net but it is nice to have it all in one place so finding all the school online becomes easier. Worth \$5-7 so get it used. This book is much better than the 13th ed of Independant school guide. The format is much better and easier to read and the front pages are better.
